CROSS STITCH PATTERN RELEASED IN SUCCESSIVE PARTS

Join the fun with **Barbara Ana's** new SAL!

Exclusive to Creative Poppy, the Up in the Air design is revealed gradually, with a new chart published every 2 weeks.

We have very little cues to provide for Barbara Ana's new stitch-along, but we can reveal that it is airy, full of lightness and that the general idea is reaching out towards the sky. It comes with lots of elements tiny or large that fit together once the stitching is complete.

The cross stitch pattern lists 11 DMC floss colors and is stitched on 32 count linen, either in a solid light brown (Amber linen from Witchelt/Permin) or with a slightly marbled effect (Vintage Country Mocha (3009) from Zweigart) Once finished, the stitched area measures about 8 x 8 inch square.

SAL release dates

Threads: DMC stranded cotton
