Despite the tongue-in-cheek phrase, all the focus of this design is really on the exquisitely ornate dragonfly, like a jewel sparking with emerald, sapphire and amethyst hues, with extra fine highlights of golden thread over its wings and body.

The rococo round frame surrounding the piece is cross stitched in golden thread. It could be omitted if you wanted to focus on the quote and dragonfly, with simple rectangular framework.
