Here is part of this beautiful house adorned for the festive season ready for the gathering of the family. Included are some Norfolk Black turkeys, always supplied by one of the Estate farms to the Queen for a traditional Christmas dinner. ”

Creative Poppy says:

We like the "indoor/outdoor" idea of this cross stitch pattern. You can look at the design as a landscape, with the brightly lit-up castle in the background and deer and turkeys roaming in the snow-covered park with partridges perched on the pear trees.

Or you can see it as an indoor scene, with a miniature castle like a doll's house on the mantelpiece, mistletoe dangling from the ceiling and the royal family's Christmas stockings hanging above the fireplace.
