This is Harvest Brew, part of the beautiful collection of Seasonal tea & Coffee cross stitch patterns designed by Deborah A. Dick of **Tempting Tangles**. Collect them all!

The pattern features a nice big pumpkin-like tea-pot, with fine berry branches seemingly growing out of it. A dainty little tea-cup sits beside it, hot tea steaming out of it.

This cross stitch pattern comes with both a color overview chart, and a detailed black and white chart. There is some stem stitch and the larger berries are stitched in a double leviathan stitch, both of which are described in detail in the instructions.

Suggested Needlework fabric: 32 ct antique white Jobelan even weave (Wichelt # 862101)

Finished size on 32 ct over 2: 6 ¼" square
