A keen and talented designer of Quaker patterns, Deborah A. Dick of **Tempting Tangles** brings a new dimension to her favorite motifs.

Although the Quaker movement began in England, small Quaker groups established themselves in other European countries, including France in 1788 in particular in southern France near Nîmes.

This pattern features the rolling landscapes of this wine region, with vineyards and villages, as well as colorful lavender fields and a powerful stream emerging from under the bridge, forming decorative waves.

A small chapel with stained glass windows and surrounding cypress trees is depicted in the lower left side, while horse carts bearing wine bottles, wine barrels and flowers ply their trade.

Further out, the city of Paris is represented with its famous landmarks - Notre Dame, the Arc de Triomphe and the Eiffel Tower - depicted in the distance. Quaker motifs fill the sky, together with the country's symbol, a cockerel.
