Thanks to Tiny Modernist, you can capture their freshness and pretty colors, in cross stitch. Herbs featured in the chart include thyme, mint, basil, parsley and sage.

**Creative Poppy tips:**

Notice the little string knots around the bunches? How about stitching those with a tiny strand of garden raffia?

Display this cute little pattern in the kitchen in a single frame with all herbs in a row, or stitch each herb individually and mount them into miniature frames. Alternative finishing ideas include small sachets filled with herbs as a gift, fridge magnets, or stitching on an Aida band that can be applied on a tea towel.
